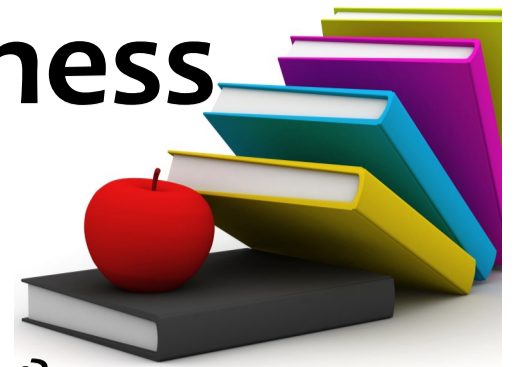

Mostly on holiday or when I can find the time to read for at least two hours straight through.

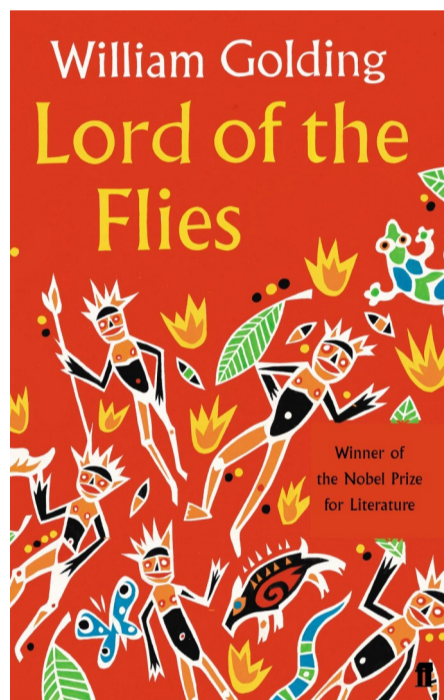
What is your favourite book ?

This has changed over the years.

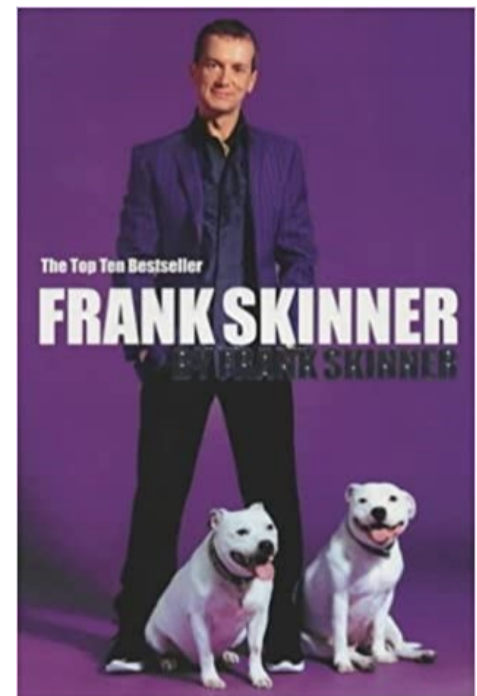
The more I think about it the more I really enjoyed studying Lord of the Flies at school.

I also love Frank Skinner's autobiography.



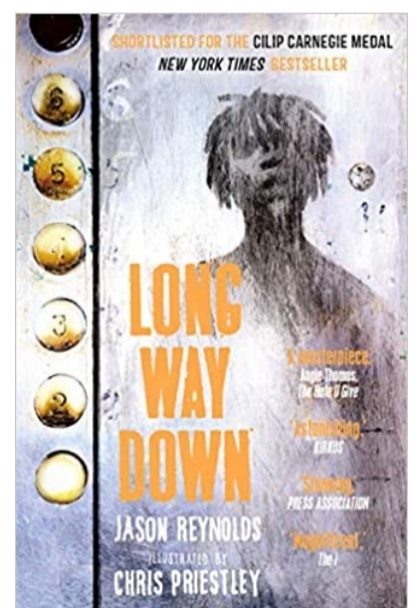
