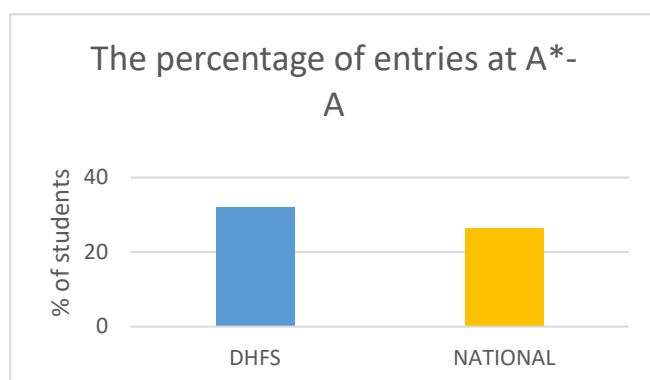

Key Stage 5 Results 2023

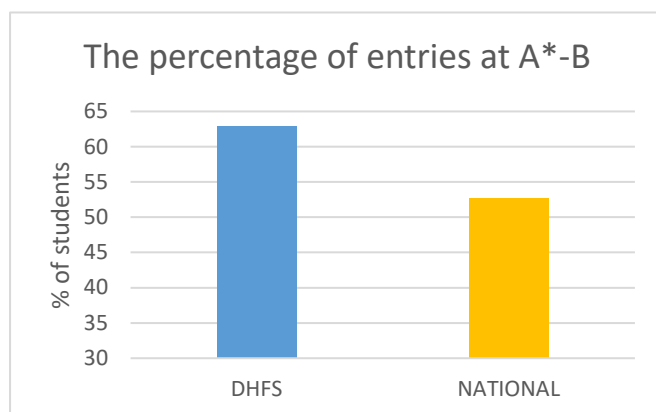

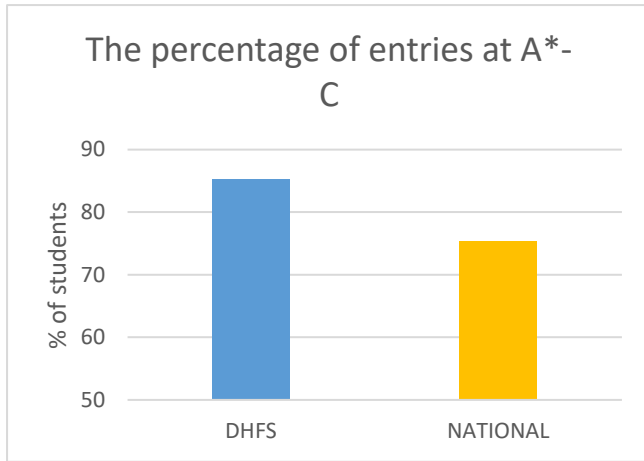
Attainment A Level



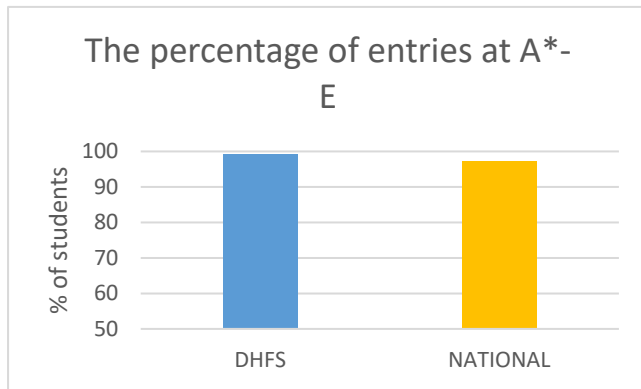
The percentage of entries at A*-A were one of our highest over a ten-year trend with 32% of all entries resulting in an A* or A. This has exceeded the national average by over 5.4%



The percentage of entries gaining an A*-B were our second highest set of results (outside of the COVID CAGs/adjusted results) with 63% of entries gaining an A*-B. This exceeded the national average by around 10.2%. It has exceeded the national average for the last ten years.

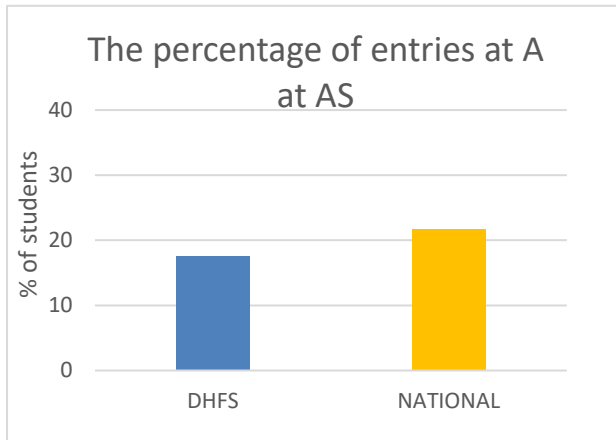


Results over the last ten years have shown excellent outcomes compared to the national average, ranging 5-8% in excess of the national average. The 2023 outcomes were nearly 10% higher than the national average with over 85% of entries with a C or above.

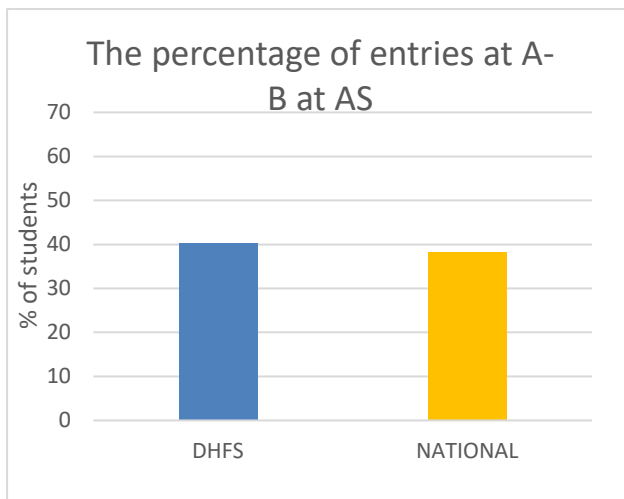


A Level pass rates remain very high at 99.2%, it exceeds the national average and has done so for the last eleven years.

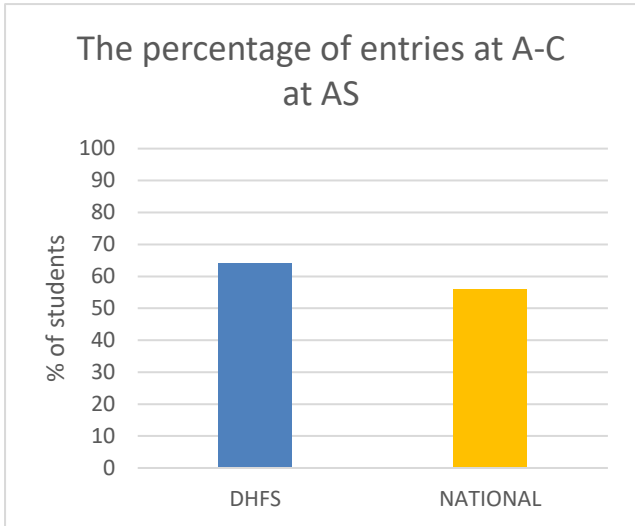
Attainment AS Level



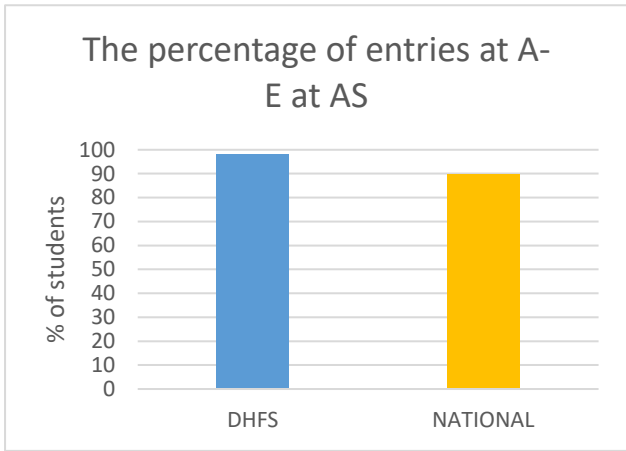
The percentage of entries at A grade were below the national average, this is the first time in the last six years since DHFS results have been below the national average.



At AS attainment remains strong with more than 40% of entries at A or B grade, exceeding the national average by 2%. Outcomes exceed national averages and have done so for nine of the last ten years.



In 2023 over 64% of AS entries were at a C grade or higher, exceeding the national average by more than 8%. At DHFS, the national average has been exceeded every year for the last eleven years.



In 2023 over 94% of AS entries were at an E grade or higher, exceeding the national average by more than 10%. At DHFS, the national average has been exceeded every year for the last eleven years.
