In the spirit of learning and growth, **Henry Fanshaw School** have collectively donated an impressive **681.8** kilograms of food in 2023. This remarkable contribution equates to more than **1623** wholesome meals, nourishing both body and mind. Since January 2023, your partnership has enabled us to provide 3-day supplies of emergency food and essentials to a total of **10,922 people**. **Among them are 7,753 adults and 3,169 children**, each benefiting from the kindness and support of educational establishments like yours.
