Dear Parent/Carer,

I write to welcome your child to Dronfield Henry Fanshawe School (DHFS) and to provide further information about the school and our transition programme for students moving from Year 6 to Year 7. We are delighted that you are joining DHFS and can't wait to meet you and begin our journey together.

Moving to secondary school is an exciting event for students and their families but can also give rise to questions particularly when the child is the oldest in a family and the process is unfamiliar. Please be assured that our aim is to ensure that every child starts Year 7 confident that they will make excellent progress, achieve success and be strongly cared for whatever their background or level of ability. The majority of our new starters will come from our nearest local schools in the Partnership of Dronfield Schools (PODS) but we have students from over 30 schools in total, and we will ensure that they all experience the best possible transition into our community. Staff from DHFS visit our local schools every year so your children may already have seen, met and spoken with key people that are an important part of the transition process. In addition, staff at DHFS regularly meet staff from PODS to plan and discuss transition arrangements to ensure as smooth and effective transfer as possible. Further to this, we have contact with schools that are outside the PODS cluster.

You will receive an Induction Pack in due course which will contain key information for you as your child begins their education with us and documentation which we will ask you to complete and return to us by a specified date. In addition to this, we will continue to work with your child's Primary school to obtain all the relevant information to secure a strong start for all students in September. If you have any questions or concerns at this stage, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Wyles via email ([swyles@dhfs.uk](mailto:swyles@dhfs.uk)) or by telephone, on the main school number (01246 412372).

Further to getting to know your child and gathering information from schools and families, we run several sessions and events that have been successful in the past, including:

1. Primary School visits: traditionally, students in schools where the majority of Year 6 will move on to us are visited by staff and students. They talk about the day-to-day work of our school, uniform, the vertical House system, what happens on the first day in September and answer any questions about DHFS that Year 6 pupils may have.
2. Induction Week: it is planned that all students will visit and spend a full week with us in Term 6 commencing Monday 20th July 2026 and finishing on Thursday 23rd July 2026 in order to begin to acquaint themselves with their fellow students, teachers and the geography of the site.
3. Induction Evening: each year we hold an evening for you and your child to meet with myself, Senior Staff and your child's support team (House Progress Leader, House Support Manager, Mentors and



Learning Support Staff) at our school. The date for this is Thursday 2nd July 2026 at 6pm. We will keep you informed as the event approaches.

4. Year 6 Disco: we are pleased to be running the popular Year 6 disco again, which is scheduled for Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2026. An excellent opportunity for all incoming students to meet each other. Further details to follow.
