Biology	6	Double 6 in GCSE Combined Science or a 6 in GCSE Biology and one other science. 6 in GCSE Mathematics. Students must also undertake continued mathematics study (A Level Mathematics, AS Level Mathematics, Core Mathematics or mathematics study as directed by the science faculty)
Business	5	5 or above in Mathematics and English Language or English Literature
