Dear Parents/Carers,

On the evening of **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023** the English Faculty intend to take a group of students to attend a production of 'An Inspector Calls' at the Lyceum Theatre in Sheffield. The primary purpose of the trip is to give KS4 students the opportunity to experience a version of one of their set texts for GCSE English Literature. It will be an extremely beneficial experience for all English Literature students, as well as anyone considering studying our subjects at A Level or university.

We are taking approximately **300** tickets for this visit, at a significantly reduced rate of **£12.00** each, and it is likely that we will shortly have a limited number of tickets available for students who did not register their interest when this visit was advertised last year.

If you would like your child to participate in this visit, please return the attached reply slip to **Mr Husband** (and not your child's English teacher) as soon as possible. Students with completed forms will be placed on a reserve list and we will offer any remaining tickets to on a first come first served basis, starting with the students who handed in their reply slip first. We will accept a physical copy of the reply slip, or a photograph of the signed slip, but we cannot accept any slips without a proper signature.

DHFS is committed to supporting families who may have experienced financial difficulties and believe our cultural trips should be accessible to all. DHFS is supporting 75% of the cost of the trip for these students. The full cost of the ticket will be £12, reduced to £3 for Pupil Premium students. We require the full payment of £12.00/£3.00 to be paid by the ParentPay system as soon as possible, but by **Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup>** at the latest. If your child is entitled to the PP discount, please indicate this on the reply slip. If we receive more than **300** of applications for a place, we will allocate places by ballot. **Once you have secured a place, the payment for this visit is non-refundable.** We will advise parents when they are able to pay for this visit.

Your child will need to be dropped outside in Tudor Square outside the Lyceum Theatre, 55 Norfolk Street, Sheffield City Centre, S1 1DA **no later than 7:15pm** to register with a member of staff and collect their ticket. In case of poor weather, we will register students in the adjacent Winter Gardens. The performance starts at **7:45pm** and is expected to run for **1hr 40minutes**. Your child will need to be collected by a responsible adult from Norfolk Street, adjacent to the theatre, at approximately **9:30pm**; your child will not be allowed to leave unaccompanied and must be collected by a responsible adult. No transport will be provided by school for this visit; as space for setting down can be limited (and in the interests of being as environmentally friendly as possible!) we would encourage students to share transport, carpool or use public transport wherever possible. A trained first aider will accompany the visit.

You will be required to complete the annual global consent form in September, allowing your child to participate in off-site activities during the school year, and whilst no further consent is required, we do require you to complete the attached reply slip to secure a place on this visit (or in the ballot should the visit be oversubscribed). Without a completed global consent form your child will not be able to participate in this visit.
