Re: Year 11 PSHE Curriculum

We are writing to inform you about the lesson content for Y11 PSHE that your child will be taking part in this year. Below is an outline of the PSHE Big Ideas and lesson topics that will be covered within them over the course of the year. They are listed in sequential order to demonstrate when they will be presented to students, and how the topics build on each other and on the prior learning of students in PSHE at KS3.

Please be aware that there will be assessment lessons within this lesson sequencing, in order to evaluate student confidence with the new content, with the aim of correcting errors or misconceptions that may arise.

There will also be a PSHE day scheduled early in the school year where students will come off timetable for the whole day to develop their knowledge of other key PSHE related issues. Information about the content of this day will come out separately, closer to the time.


